A Bill to Retest Elders for Their Driver's License

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. Elderly drivers will be forced to retake their driver's test every 3 years to ensure their driving capabilities. Those who fail will be suspended from driving until they pass, forced to wait 2 weeks before retesting, and required to take a vision test.

SECTION 2. "Elders" shall be defined as anyone over the age of 65. "Driving Capabilities" will be determined by the Ohio BMV. The vision test will include the standard test already implemented..

Explanation

Green Highlighted: Section 3 is always used to state who or what will be in charge of the bill, including how much they are given to do so.
